Hello. I hope this is the correct email to send this notice to. I am a Delta area landowner and have been watching all the Delta reports come out over the last several months. I recommended that the Delta be recognized as its own region for California, since we keep being obscured in the "Central Valley" region, which is so large and diverse that it's hard to adequately publicize.

Here's an example: The California State Parks Planning Division has published a draft plan for additional parks...Where's the Delta in all of this? http://www.parks.ca.gov/?page_id=23483 On page 19, not clearly delineated, and the long form name is used: Sacramento/San Joaquin Delta. Can't we all just call the region the **California Delta**, and get the various California agencies to clearly mark the boundaries? If the Delta Vision group is interested in being proactive, perhaps the Central Valley park planners should be aware of your recommendation to designate the Delta as a "National Heritage" area?
